



Helicopter Landing Protocol

Dated April 2017

1. The Club House location is on Hellipaddy and you may receive contact from the pilot to make a scheduled landing. The pilot must give at least 24 hours' notice.
2. Co-ordinates: N50 degrees 40.578' W2 degrees 39.927'.
 - 2a. Helicopter size – Single engine helicopter only, no bigger than a 5-seater, including the pilot.
3. Strictly daylight landings only.
4. Request a time for the landing and how many guests.
5. Inform the Team Leader for the day.
6. Before the scheduled landing, inform all customers of the landing.
7. Keep all customers, animals (dogs) and staff well away from the elevated grassed area.
8. Team Leader to wear high visibility jacket and safety glasses at all times until the helicopter has landed and it is safe to approach, or it has taken off and has cleared the vicinity.
 - 8a. Two fire extinguishers are located at the steps of the helipad during the landing and take-off period.
9. All litter and loose material to be removed from site prior to scheduled landing to avoid risk when downwash occurs.
